What can you do to help make the group a safe environment and encourage people to respond?

What do we do that encourages people to respond?

INTENTIONAL LEADER

How did you personally contribute to the environment?

What could being an intentional leader look like for you this week?

Where did you see the Holy Spirit at work?

Which aspect of leadership would you like more instruction or practice?
